6.3.2 Prohibited Signs

The following signs, sign conditions and sign components are prohibited in all Planning Districts.

G. Sandwich board, A-frame, Easel or equivalent temporary/portable signs (ADD- except in the Village Center or Gateway Corridor Districts as provided for in section 6.3.4 B (10)

6.3.4 Temporary Signs

B. Requirements by Sign Type

(ADD)

- 10. Sandwich board, A-frame, Easel or equivalent temporary/portable signs in Village Center and Gateway Corridor Districts
 - a) General Requirements
 - i) A maximum of 1 sign is allowed per building entrance
 - ii) Any such sign must be free standing
 - iii) Any such sign can only be displayed during business hours
 - iv) Any such sign must be constructed of natural, or natural looking materials
 - v) No neon or fluorescent lettering is allowed
 - vi) Logos are limited to those of the specific business displaying the sign
 - vii) The sign may not be illuminated
 - viii) The design must be approved by the Joint Review Board
 - b) Requirements for such signs displayed in the Village Center District
 - i) The sign can be no more than 6 sq. ft per side
 - ii) The sign must be located as close to the building as possible and no further than 3 feet from the building entrance
 - iii) The sign location must allow for 6 feet of clearance from the roadside edge of the sidewalk
 - c) Requirements for such signs displayed in the Gateway Corridor District
 - i) The sign can be no more than 8 sq. ft per side
 - ii) The sign must be located within 20 feet of the building and can not be located within any vehicle right-of-way
