

6.3.4 Temporary Signs – EXISTING LANGUAGE

B. Requirements by Sign Type

3. Flags

- a) A flag with a brief commercial message, i.e., "Open," may be displayed during the hours of commercial operation, may not exceed 12 square feet in area, and may only be displayed in the Gateway Corridor, Old Military Corridor and Rural Countryside districts.
- b) Shall not exceed two flags per lot
- c) Each flag shall not exceed 24 square feet in area
- d) Shall be flown from freestanding or projecting flagpoles
- e) Shall have a vertical clearance from sidewalk or at least seven feet, and shall not physically or visually impair vehicular or pedestrian traffic

6.3.4 Temporary Signs

B. Requirements by sign type

3. *Flags*

a) *General Requirements*

- i. *All flags associated with commercial uses shall be flown from freestanding or projecting flagpoles*
- ii. *All flags associated with commercial uses shall have a vertical clearance from the sidewalk of at least seven feet, and shall not physically or visually impair vehicular or pedestrian traffic*

b) *Regulations for the Village Corridor District*

- i. *Only those commercial uses prohibited from displaying a sandwich board (see proposed 6.3.4 (B 10)) may display a flag*
- ii. *The flag may not indicate the commercial activity is open, but may contain a logo for the commercial use involved*
- iii. *The design and color must be approved by the Joint Review Board*
- iv. *Flags shall not exceed 15 square feet in size*
- v. *Only one flag is allowed per lot*

c) *Regulations for the Gateway Corridor, Old Military Corridor and Rural Countryside Districts.*

- i. *Flags with a brief commercial message, i.e., "Open," may be displayed during the hours of commercial operation*
- ii. *Flags shall not exceed 24 square feet in size*
- iii. *The number of flags shall not exceed 2 flags per lot*
